



F/old Map is a Map of Berlin that needs to be performed.

Hiding the potential of a functional map, it needs to be folded and continuously worked over. Taking on Deleuze's Idea of an Origami Universe, in which the difference of two terms is already a third, these become folds in the plane of potential. The fold itself becomes the connection, the angle that works and handles these different actualisations. The map loses its primary function as a tool of rational movement (navigation) and deconstructs the singularity of a determined spatialisation. Whilst performing F/old Map, the user of the map is forced into a process of folding and unfolding, the actualisation of an object that questions their own state of spatiotemporal differentiation in the present moment.


Fold Map
